SPECIFIC AREA WHERE DUMPSTER IS TO BE LOCATED: \*Dumpsters must be placed on a macadam or concrete surface located on the property owner's property. This location must be next to the public alley or street, so the Borough crews can empty it without going on private property. Dumpsters may not be placed in the alley or street without written permission from the Borough, which could take up to a week.

**FEEES:**  
\* EMPTY FEE: Empty fees are to be pre-paid by mail or in person at the Borough Office during regular business hours. **NO EXCEPTIONS**  
\*RE-DELIVERY FEE: A \$10 charge will be applied if a dumpster is to be re-delivered within 30 days of removal date, only if the circumstance on why the dumpster was removed is because of non payment of invoice. This applies to continuing on or starting of a new project. Dumpsters will only be re-delivered once all outstanding invoices are paid.  
\*NON-USE FEE: A rental fee will be applied for every 30-day period in which the dumpster is not used. This non-use rental fee is \$20 for a 1-yd. dumpster and \$40 for a 2-yd. dumpster. The 30-day period is calculated from delivery date, however, the 30-day period begins again with each empty service. (Example: Delivered 12/30/06. 30-day non-use period would run from 12/30/06 through 01/30/07. However, if it is emptied on 1/15/07, the 30-day non-use period begins again and would run from 1/15/07 to 2/15/07.)  
\*EMPTY FEE: Customers are charged EACH TIME the dumpster is emptied. The empty fee is \$40 for a 1-yd. dumpster and \$80 for a 2-yd. dumpster. Customers must pre-pay an "empty" request. The customer should clearly state "empty and leave there" or "empty and remove" when payment for empty is made.  
\*REMOVAL FEE: The last time a dumpster is to be emptied, the customer should notify us to "empty and remove". If this proper procedure is followed, there will be no removal fee in addition to the empty fee. If a customer orders "empty and leave there" and later decides that he/she wants it removed, a removal fee will be charged, even though it is empty. The fee will be \$20 for a 1-yd. dumpster and \$30 for a 2-yd. dumpster. This fee will be charged because labor and equipment are used to provide the removal service. It is to the customer's advantage to order "empty and leave" only if they plan on continuing to use the dumpster.

**BILLING AND PAYMENT TIME LIMITS:**

An invoice will be issued when:

- The customer incurs a non-use fee charge.
- The customer exceeds the maximum weight capacity and/or damages the dumpster due to it being overweight.
- Prohibited items are found in the dumpster.

**Otherwise all fees are to be pre-paid.**

*All payments are due upon receipt of invoice.*

If payment is not received within thirty days the Borough will not send out second notices. We will simply remove the dumpster. A re-delivery fee may apply, if the dumpster is needed within a thirty day period of time from removal.

**MATERIALS ALLOWED TO BE PUT INTO DUMPSTER FOR COLLECTION:**

Dumpsters are primarily used for either "construction and demolition waste"(by homeowners only) or for special clean up projects when the property owner does not want to pre schedule a "Bulky Waste Pick-Up."

**\*PERMITTED MATERIALS:**

-Regular refuse: same guidelines that apply to weekly refuse collection

-Construction/demolition materials:

- \*lumber
- \*roofing material
- \*insulation
- \*macadam/bricks (only if crushed into marble-size pieces)
- \*conduit
- \*sheathing
- \*plaster
- \*pipe
- \*\* asbestos materials**
- call office for clarification**

**\*PROHIBITED MATERIALS:**

- \*concrete
- \*stone
- \*grass/sod
- \*car parts
- \*hazardous wastes (including batteries, paints, stains, etc.)
- \*all waste generated outside the Borough
- \*friable asbestos-powder form
- \*tires
- \*yardwaste
- \*appliances
- \*motor oil/lubricants
- \*medical wastes
- \*pesticides/herbicides
- \*liquid waste

**WEIGHT CAPACITY DAMAGES:** The maximum weight capacity shall be 2 tons. If the weight exceeds this amount, the applicant will be charged additional fees. The additional fee is based on the current fee per ton set by GLRA times the additional weight above 2 tons. If the dumpster is damaged due to being overweight, the applicant shall be responsible for the costs to repair. **If there is any question about whether or not an item is "permitted" waste, please call the Borough office (838-6361).**

If prohibited items are found in the dumpster when it is being emptied, the Borough will:

- a) charge the applicant additional fees for disposal, labor, and equipment (minimum \$100), OR
- b) return the waste to the property owner's property and charge labor and equipment for the time to return such waste, AND/OR
- c) seek further action against the property owner, AND/OR
- d) prevent the applicant from obtaining permission to use Borough dumpsters in the future.

I have read the information on this form and agree to abide by all these requirements and to pay all charges upon receipt.
