

Chapter 120

MOBILE HOMES

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Upland 9-16-1969 as Ch. 48 of the 1969 Code. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 120-1. Use of automobile trailers and mobile homes for dwelling prohibited.

The use of automobile trailers and mobile homes for dwelling purposes is hereby prohibited at any place within the Borough of Upland.

§ 120-2. Parking or stopping on land for storage purposes permitted. ¹

Parking or stopping of trailers which can be towed by a standard automobile, mobile homes, camper trailers, trailer coaches and trailers, on tracts of land owned by any person for the seasonal or temporary storage of any such devices is hereby permitted.

§ 120-3. Parking for storage purposes on streets prohibited. ²

The storage of said devices on any public street, alley or parking lot customarily intended for the parking of automobiles or light trucks is hereby prohibited.

§ 120-4. Violations and penalties. [Amended 7-12-1988 by Ord. No. 7-1988]³

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than six hundred dollars (\$600.) and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days. Each day a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense, which shall be punishable as such hereunder.
